In regard to the annexation by Edgerton of KCP&L, the residents have agreed to the terms that the City of Edgerton had proposed and that negotiations between the City of Edgerton and KCP&L would now begin. Chief Sielert also reported that there was nothing new to report on the Intermodal.

Chief Sielert reported the 2004 audit will be completed before the start of the 2005 audit. Chief also reported paging or e-mail is now available through cell phone if the Fire Board wished to be included in that.

Chief Sielert reported receiving a call from an attorney who wanted to take a deposition regarding the corrections building fire from a few years ago. He reported he had spoken to county legal and that Leigh Ann Hay will be present with the district during those depositions.

Chief McGuire reported the Christmas Party is December 8th at Austin's. He also reported that the KU Burn Trailer will be in the City of Gardner next week and some of our staff will be sent for this training as well as smoke trailer training which will be done in pairs. We are working on obtaining joint training with Gardner DPS staff. Chief McGuire elaborated on the CC Alert System; a new paging system. This is an additional way of getting information to the employees - the use of e-mail, phone, or pager. There is a \$50 per month fee which is waived until after next year, and for every referral contact they will give us two months free. Chief McGuire was also a participant on an 2006 international building and codes committee. These codes are to be adopted by the county commissioners and we will be going from the 2000 to the 2006 code.

Chief McGuire also informed the board that beginning October 1, a new CPR procedure will be initiated and will be called CCR - cardio cerebral resuscitation. Compressions are done now, not airway, for six minutes, and this is the way of the future. American Heart Association and American Red Cross will both be changing procedures.

Chief McGuire reported this has been fire prevention week, but our district had not done anything organized, but that a crew did go to Gardner Elementary on a special request, and that some materials had been sent to Edgerton Elementary.

Also reported were completion of EMT refreshers. The concrete repairs are almost completed and the next step is power washing and sealing.
