Chief Sielert reported he had not heard from the 2007 AFG grant for airpacks and FIT testing equipment which was for \$36 - \$37,000; however there has not been a rejection letter yet. He reported that he, Chief McGuire and Trigg Morley will be taking the last required class for NIMS which should complete the requirement for federal funds. He reported he will be meeting with Stewart Fairburn, Gardner City Administrator next week to review the contract which ended in 2007. The Board requested Chief Sielert present costs and expansion information; provide previous statistics and compare them to the current costs especially in light of the amount of land now being considered for annexation by Gardner.
